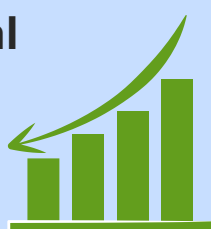


Mission:

Current Model for Mental Health Crisis



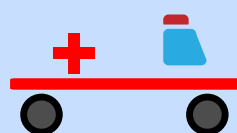
Citizen calls 911

MOBILE CRISIS RESPONSE MODEL:

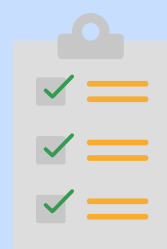
Respond~Resolve~Refer



- CCCRT will RESPOND to 911 psychiatric/mental health calls in a specialized unit.
- CCCRT will provide onsite intervention to de-escalate and RESOLVE mental health crises.
- Co-Responders will REFER individuals to community mental health providers and other resources as needed.

Future of the Program:

- Create a strategic plan for the operation of the Crisis Response Unit to include all vested stakeholders
- Expand crisis response team from one, to multiple teams to decrease response times and increase in-service hours.
